MIALISE CARNEY | Creative Writing, M.F.A.

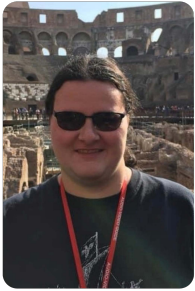

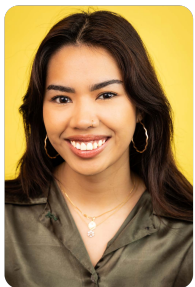
JEGO CANLAS | Music, B.A.
